



## In the P I N K

The skin of **pink lemons** has subtle green stripes, while the flesh is a rosy hue. As the lemons mature, the stripes fade and the color inside intensifies. Small amounts of lycopene (the red compound present in tomatoes) give pink lemons their lovely color. Pink lemons become sweeter than common lemons as they ripen.
